The On Track maths workbooks are written for middle-band students who benefit from some revision of previous work before they advance to the next level.

Tips for Students

- You need a scientific calculator. Keep the instruction booklet and learn how to use your calculator efficiently.
- Never accept the answer on your calculator at face value, check it. Often your answer will need a unit e.g. \$, km, min.
- Work out difficult questions on scrap paper first and write any explanations in brief sentences.
- ◆ At the end of each chapter is a revision test. Save this test until you are ready to do it without help. The result will give you an indication of how well you have understood the maths in that chapter. Revise any weak areas.

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
